GOSPEL READING

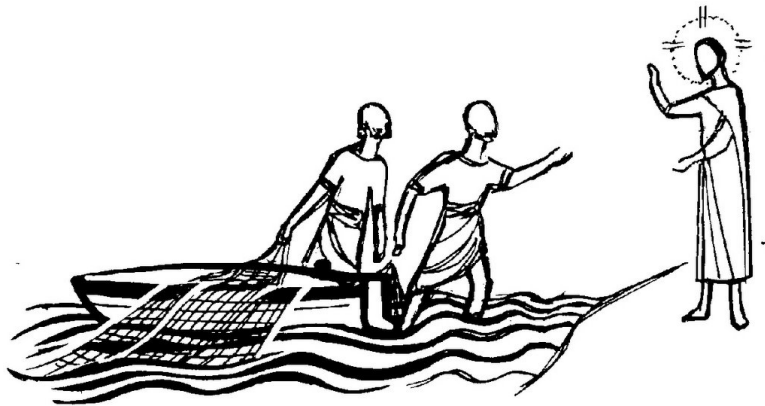
